7. Must have a valid social security number (Proof will be required) and state picture ID.

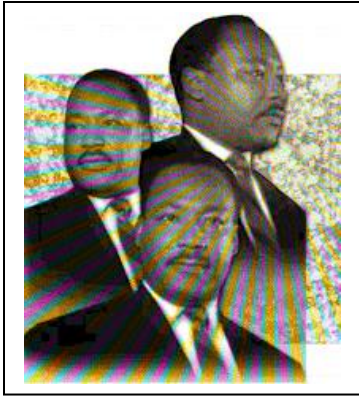
