- Provide coordinating supervisor information – Agency name, phone #, address, supervisor's name, title, state dental license # (if applicable)

Print pdf, fill-out completely, sign and upload if you wish to be considered for scholarship funding by the ADA for the program. *On the bookstore form, last page of this pdf, fill out name, student id and your shipping address for where you would want your books to be mailed if you receive scholarship. You do not need to fill in book titles or courses.*

- Dental Assisting School diploma
- Letter from employer verifying 3500 hours of dental assisting experience

AND

REQUIRED COMPETENCIES for *Dental Assistants Only* (Upload one of the following forms from each section)

Ability to take radiographs (Examples of documentation):

- State radiology certificate or license
- Successful completion of RHS DANB© exam
- Successful completion of a course in radiology
- Not required by state

Ability to place sealants and fluoride (Examples of documentation):

- State certificate or license to place sealants
- Successful completion of SE, CPFDA, or CRFDA DANB© exams
- Successful completion of a course in sealant placement and fluoride
- Not required by state

Ability to perform coronal polishing (Examples of documentation):

- State certificate or license to perform coronal polishing
- Successful completion of CP or CPFDA DANB© exams
- Successful completion of a course in coronal polishing
- Not required by state

Ability to identify suspicious lesions (Examples of documentation):

- Successful completion of a continuing education course in oral pathology
