Rheanan Heller made history on May 2, 2024 as the first Arizona college student recognized for earning a bachelor's degree at a community college. She completed a degree in public safety administration, one of two bachelor's degrees the college launched in fall 2023.

Rheanan completed her program in about a year, at community college tuition rates, through accelerated classes and a lot of hard work. "I wasn't considering going back to school at all," she said. "I knew that financially, it was going wait until a miracle fell from the heavens and that miracle was Rio getting its public safety administration [degree] program."
