Clinical Dental Assisting Program Review

Review Conducted: AY2017-18

Decision to terminate the Program

- The current accreditation status of the Rio Salado College (RSC) Clinical Dental Assisting Program is: Accredited without reporting requirements.
- Since 2013, the CCL in Clinical Dental Assisting Program has conducted annual reviews of enrollment and completion data, showing an average 10-12 enrollments per year and consistently poor completion rates (see Table 1 below).
- The RSC Dental Programs department has an active Advisory Council which meets every year. Low enrollments have been discussed at every council meeting.
- During the prior two years, Dental Programs has worked on outreach, attending 13
 events in an effort to increase enrollment. Examples include: Maricopa Early College
 Programs STEM Conference, SOAR events, I will Graduate event, Career and Resource
 Fair at Phoenix College.
- In AY2017-18, a review of instructional costs and justification was presented to the RSC Vice President of Academic Affairs and the Academic Dean overseeing the program.
- In spring 2018 interest remained low, with no prospects of an increase in enrollment for fall 2018.
- No class was accepted for spring 2018.
- The decision was made by RSC Dental and Administrative personnel to discontinue the program.
- The intent to discontinue was presented to the Arizona Dental Association (AzDA) in March 2018 to garner their support.
- A letter was sent to the Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA) of RSC's intent to discontinue the accredited Clinical Dental Assisting program.
- The last day for enrolled students was July 30, 2018, and the discontinuation of accreditation was requested for August 30, 2018.
- A teach-out report will follow to the Commission on Dental Accreditation.
- Below is a summary of enrollment and retention/completion rates over time, representing one of the factors used in the decision to discontinue the Clinical Dental Assisting Program.
