# Math Pathway within the AA & AAS Degree's Offered in the IRE Correspondence Program

## Degree Options in the IRE Correspondence Program:

- AA Degree (Transferable to 4-year university) needs MAT145 (combination of MAT103 and MAT142. There is no prerequisite.) *See the transfer path for a degree at a 4-year university.*
- ASD AAS Degree needs MAT145 (*minimum requirement, see transfer path to a 4-year university.*)
- General Studies AAS Degree needs MAT145
- WFR AAS Degree needs MAT145

## Math path for students interested degree at a 4-year university:

- MAT114 > MAT152 > MAT212 (**Business degree at a 4- year university - please check with your future university on program requirements**)
- MAT114 > MAT152 > MAT187 > MAT221 (**Engineering/Technology/Science**)
- MAT145 (**Education, Sociology, History, Religion, Humanities, Criminal Justice, Social Work, Healthcare, Communications degree at a 4- year university – please check with your future university on program requirements**)
- MAT114 > MAT152 > MAT187 (**Psychology degree at a 4- year university – please check with your future university on program requirements**)
- Students with credits from another college should submit an official transcript for evaluation toward desired degree prior to taking courses.
