Rio Salado College offers a Hybrid General Instructor class for law enforcement professionals. This hybrid course is a blend of in-person and online classes.

This class is designed to aid persons responsible for training in the workplace. Emphasis on motivating the adult learner, systematic training, planning, and evaluating performance.

Requirements for successful completion of the course and recognition as an AZPOST General Instructor:

- Mandatory attendance in all classroom blocks of instruction
- Successful completion of four oral presentations
- Successfully pass the “open book” final exam with a score of 100%
- Successful completion receives 3 credit hours
