LET243 Search Warrant

Rio Salado College offers an Online Search Warrant Preparation course for law enforcement professionals.

This class provides an overview of statutes, constitutional requirements, and case law covering searches, seizures, and detentions relative to the search warrant process. It also includes procedures and tactical considerations for obtaining and serving search warrants, and reviews documentation of probable cause related to property, persons, and drug-related crimes in a search warrant affidavit. Builds on the skills taught in the Investigator Training course.

After completing LET 243, officers may apply for 64 hours of continuous training through AZPOST. Officers will receive 6 credit hours and a Certificate of Completion (CCL) in Search Warrant Preparation through Rio Salado College.
