We look forward to celebrating your academic achievements at this year's commencement ceremony. The following details will help you and your guests prepare for this special occasion.



#### **GRADUATE RECOGNITIONS**

Each graduate's name and one credential will be announced. Graduates will receive a diploma cover, have photos taken on stage alone and with President Smith. All graduate credentials will be listed in the program. Graduates who registered after the March 31 deadline may not appear in the program. Graduates will receive diplomas via mail.

Graduates will enter the auditorium as part of the processional and have assigned seating. Graduates will exit the auditorium as part of the recessional to meet guests at the front of the theatre.
